can be scaled to any size without losing detail and quality

excellent for photographs and digital paintings

composed of grids of pixels or dots.

ideal for logos and illustrations

sharp and crisp outlines

resolution-dependent

resolution-independent

reproduce color gradations well

generated from mathematical descriptions

can appear jagged or lose image quality when scaled

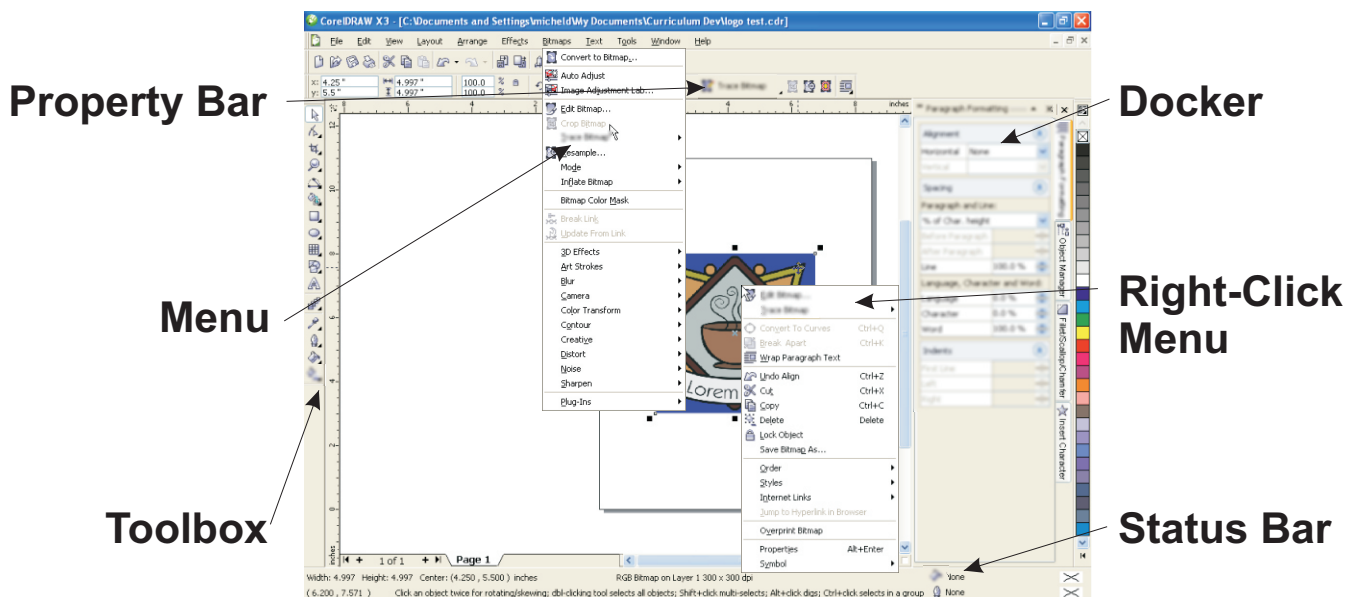
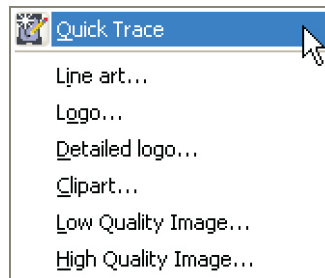


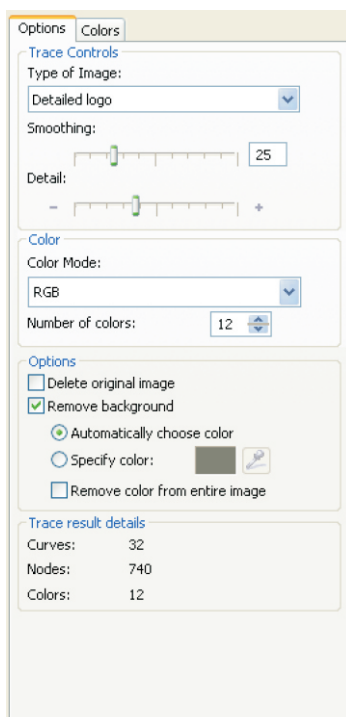
Image Type
