### What does it do:

The Corel Migration Manager is a standalone utility designed to facilitate the migration from earlier versions of WordPerfect® (versions 6.1 through 9) to the most current version WordPerfect® Office 2002. The Migration Manager will enable users to back up and migrate important files and registry settings, such as default templates, customized toolbars, macros, address books, user word lists and Quick Words.

# There is a New Automation improvement with WordPerfect Service Pack 2

This improvement allows developers to now Turn Off Error Message Boxes as well as trap the errors from their Automation Client and handle them. This improvement will make automating WordPerfect on a IIS Server, much more automatable.

Below it is described how it works as well as how to handle the errors from your Automation Client.

### Command line parameter

New command line parameter for WordPerfect: Wpwin10.exe /noerrmsg=<on|off>

# Usage of /noerrmsg=<on|off> command line parameter :

To turn off the error message box display, run: wpwin10.exe /noerrmsg=on

### WordPerfect will create/update registry key

[\\HKEY\_CURRENT\_USER\\Software\\Corel\\WordPerfect\\10\\Macro] "Error Message"=hex(80000009):01,00,00,00

To turn on the error message box display, run: wpwin10.exe /noerrmsg=off

### WordPerfect will create/update registry key

[\\HKEY\_CURRENT\_USER\\Software\\Corel\\WordPerfect\\10\\Macro] "Error Message"=hex(80000009):00,00,00,00

WordPerfect will check to see if this registry key is set. If it is set, WordPerfect will turn off error message box. Otherwise, WordPerfect will display error message box.

Run WordPerfect without /noerrmsg=<on|off> command line parameter will not change the value of this registry key. That is to say, the registry key will keep the same value until user manually change it or user run WordPerfect with the /noerrmsg=<on|off> command line parameter to change it.

### **Example:**

wpwin10.exe /noerrmsg=on

Turn off the error message box display. You then could keep WordPerfect running or close it. After that user can run WordPerfect manually or through Automation Client without this parameter, error message box display will still be turned off. **Until you run** wpwin10.exe /noerrmsg=off

To turn on error message box display. User then could keep WordPerfect running or close it. After that you can run WordPerfect manually or through Automation Client without this parameter, error message box display will still be turned on.

### How to notify Automation Client.

### WordPerfect will notify Automation Client via OLE exception. Information returned via

### How Automation Client get's the error

Automation client could use any language which would catch OLE exception to get the error

### Visual Basic Example:

- 1. Use On Error statement to catch up error
- 2. Err object: Err.number is 65445

Err.Description should be the error information

3. Parse Error information return by Err. Desciption

Error information was separated by: ";\n\n"

The first Error information is: "Total error number is: n" (n is total error number)

Then followed by n error information items each was separated by ";\n\n"
